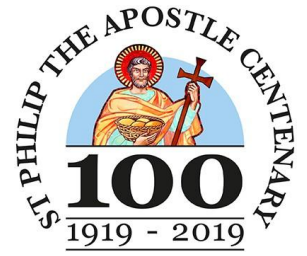


CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS



THE CENTENARY WALK



Sunday 19th May 2019 at 1-00pm

**Meet outside East Finchley tube station
at 12-50pm for a 1-00pm start**

From East Finchley tube station we will wend our way back to St Philip's via no less than 14 distinct and separate green spaces. First we head for Lytton Playing Fields and follow Mutton Brook through Northway Gardens to Little Wood where we will stop for a packed lunch. From here we take footpaths alongside Basing Way to St Marylebone Cemetery and the cascading Willow Tree Water Gardens. Then we visit The Garden of Hope, Long Lane Pasture, Briarfield Green Square and head home along The Avenue. This is a very pretty walk that will show you parts of Finchley that you may not know existed.

The pace will be leisurely and there are drop out points along the way.
We recommend you bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water with you.

Total distance of the walk is 4.1 miles.
