Dear Parishioners,

As the number of disciples increased steadily in the early Church, the pastoral needs of that growing number also grew. The apostles had no hesitation in responding to those needs by establishing the ministry of deacon, but it became apparent fairly quickly that the work undertaken by at least a couple of those deacons expanded to include evangelisation as well as pastoral care.

The world continues to change at an accelerating pace, and the pastoral and social needs that we experience also continue to evolve. Like the apostles, we need to be open to the prompting of the Holy Spirit, to recognise how we can respond to those changing needs, using the gifts that God has entrusted to us.

St Peter referred to the followers of Christ as living stones making up a spiritual house, built on the foundations laid down by the apostles. Christ is the corner stone of that dwelling. His love provides the essential support for all that we do in his name. This weekend, we celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III. It is a special moment for each one of us. We pray for the King, recognising that he relies on each one of us to help him in fulfilling his pledge to draw together people of different backgrounds, so that we can face the future together in a spirit of hope.
